How have you shared your learning, and supported learning within your community? A strong portfolio will include multiple pieces of evidence from a variety of sources and in a variety of formats. You may include evidence such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Letters from community members describing your community service - A personal reflection detailing how you have contributed to your community - Any other evidence that will help the selection committee to understand how you have contributed to learning in your community <p>Proof of enrollment in a post-secondary educational institution. If you have not received proof of enrollment before the application deadline, please forward your proof of enrollment ASAP. Funds will only be released to successful applicants with proof of enrollment.</p>
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Our selection committee will use the following criteria to select the four scholarship recipients.	
Academic growth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The applicant has provided detailed evidence of significant academic growth in a range of subjects. - The applicant has identified how they actively sought out and made use of strategies and supports that aided their academic growth. - The applicant has identified growth in their learning behaviours (engaged citizen, sense of self, work habits, and life long learning).
Community Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The applicant has provided detailed evidence of significant contributions made to their community. - The applicant has identified how they have actively engaged their community to share or promote learning.



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	- The applicant has provided evidence of the impact their contributions have had on community members.
